

Participant Terms and Conditions

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1. Introduction

Eurosea 17 is an event designed to encourage international water scouts to meet each other in an international setting. The event aims to promote the exchange of knowledge through seminars and to provide an experience of water scouting in the Netherlands through water-scouting-related activities. Eurosea 17 will take place from Wednesday, August 5th to Sunday, August 9th, 2026, at “het Avonturenhuis” on the Scouting Nederland estate in Zeewolde. Participants of Eurosea will be guests at Nawaka but will not be part of Nawaka. When this document refers to 'the event', it means Eurosea 17.

2. General Terms and Conditions

- 2.1 Scouting Nederland is the organizing party of the event and thus the contractual party for the participants.
- 2.2 Eurosea 17 will be held at the ‘Scouting Landgoed Zeewolde’ (SLZ). Participants will arrive on Wednesday, August 5th, 2026, and depart on Sunday, August 9th, 2026.
- 2.3 The event rules, the code of conduct, and the house rules of Scouting Nederland are integral to these participant terms and conditions. By registering for the event, the participant agrees to abide by these rules. The Eurosea 17 camp rules can be found on the website www.eurosea.scouting.nl.
- 2.4 Eurosea17 is organized for the leadership/management of water scouts, and participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of Eurosea. Participation is only through registration with their national scouting organization (NSO). The organization accepts a maximum of 3 participants per country. If there is room after the initial registration period, additional participants may be accepted from countries that like to register more participants than 3. .

3. Registration Procedure

- 3.1 Registration for the event will be open from February 1st, 2026.
- 3.2 Registration takes place through the NSO (the contact person is usually the International Commissioner), after which individual participants will receive a separate registration form that can be filled out digitally.
- 3.3 Each individual participant is bound by these terms and conditions.
- 3.4 A confirmation email will be sent after registration.
- 3.5 The final registration deadline is Friday, May 15th, 2026.
- 3.6 The number of participants can be modified free of charge up to May 15th, 2026.
- 3.7 After May 15th, 2026, no refunds or adjustments will be made for a reduced number of participants.
- 3.8 If the maximum number of participants (Based on 3 participants per NSO, with a total of 70 participants from all NSOs combined) is reached before May 15th 2026, registration will close early. From then, new registrations will be placed on a waiting list. The contact person will be informed that they are on the waiting list.
- 3.9 After May 15th, 2026, changing the number of participants or cancellations will not be possible. A replacement participant can be registered free of charge up to May 15th, 2026, provided it does not affect dietary or special needs. Contact the Eurosea 17 secretary (info@eurosea.scouting.nl) for this.
- 3.10 Personal information (including dietary preferences) must be submitted by May 15th, 2026. Participants will be informed by email on how to provide this information as soon as possible after the submission has been approved by the hosting organization.

4. Participant Contribution & Payment

4.1 The participation fee per person is set at €599.

4.2 The participation fee includes:

- Meals from dinner on the arrival day to lunch on the departure day.
- Participation in the event, including accommodation (Avonturenhuis, beds inside, bedding not included, pillows are available) , program, and services.
- Information throughout the entire process.

The participation fee does not include:

- Travel costs to and from the campsite (except for transport between Nijkerk station and the campsite).
- Parking fees for participants' cars/motorcycles (if applicable from the Nawaka event where participants are allowed to park).

4.3 The payment must be completed in full by May 15th, 2026.

4.4 If the payment deadline is missed, a reminder will be sent. If the payment is not received within the specified period in the reminder, the participant will be excluded, and payment will still be due.

4.5 If a participant does not wish to or cannot take part in certain activities or facilities, without cancellation or exclusion, there will be no refund.

5. Cancellation

5.1 Full cancellation of group participation or individual participation can be done free of charge by the contact person until May 15th, 2026. 5.2 Cancellations after May 15th, 2026, will not be refunded.

5.2 Cancellations must be reported by email to the organization at info@eurosea.scouting.nl. Cancellations are only final once confirmed by the organization.

5.3 If the organization decides to cancel a participant's registration before the event starts, the participation fee will be refunded, excluding costs for already provided services.

5.4 If the event is canceled or rescheduled due to force majeure (an event beyond Scouting Nederland's control), the organization may decide to cancel or partially cancel participation. In such a case, the paid participation fee will be refunded, excluding the cost of non-reversible services provided.

6. Insurance & Liability

6.1 Travel, baggage, and cancellation insurance are not included in the participation fee. The participant is responsible for obtaining any necessary insurance.

6.2 No separate insurance will be provided for liability, medical expenses, or accidents. It is assumed that every participant is covered by their own insurance.

6.3 The participant is liable for any damage caused to Scouting Nederland or others.

6.4 Scouting Nederland is only liable for damage, such as loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings, if it can be proven to be due to the intent or gross negligence of the organization and/or Scouting Nederland.

- Liability is limited to the value of the participation agreement and never exceeds the amount paid by Scouting Nederland's liability insurer, including the deductible amount.
- Scouting Nederland is not liable for financial incapacity of any service provider involved in the agreement.
- Scouting Nederland is not liable for any damage covered by the participant's insurance policies (medical/accident, travel, or cancellation insurance).
- Scouting Nederland is never liable for indirect or consequential damages, such as loss of profit, missed savings, or business interruptions.

7. Safety & Health

- 7.1 The participant is responsible for providing any dietary requirements to the organization via the designated form in a timely manner, dietary requirements provided after May 15th cannot be guaranteed.
- 7.2 The food will consist of a basic meal package, with simple dietary modifications possible. Any extra costs for special diets will be covered by the participant, after consultation.
- 7.3 If the participant's physical or mental condition raises doubts about their suitability for participation, the organization may exclude the participant from further participation.
- 7.4 Rules regarding alcohol, drugs, and smoking will be specified in the camp regulations. Every participant must adhere to these rules.
- 7.5 By agreeing to these terms, the participant grants permission for emergency medical treatment if necessary.
- 7.6 The participant is expected to share relevant health information with the organization when visiting the first aid station.
- 7.7 According to the Dutch law every participant must be able to show a legal identification document at any time. When medical assistance is needed outside the event, the participant has to fulfill the fee therefore by themselves and arrange the declaration by their own insurance.

8. Social Safety & Safe from harm

- 8.1 The participant is required to have completed the WOSM Safe from Harm training before the event and must send proof to info@eurosea.scouting.nl. If the training is not completed, the participant will be excluded from participating at Eurosea without refund.
- 8.2 During the event an independent confidential advisor will be contactable during the event by email and phone. Contact details will be shared at the beginning of the event.

9. Communication & Privacy

- 9.1 The personal data provided in the registration form will only be used for the purpose of the event. The data will not be shared with third parties and will be destroyed after the event. The data will only be accessible to those who need it to perform their role in the organization.
- 9.2 Communication with participants will primarily be via email. The participant is responsible for providing a valid email address and agrees to receive communication at this address.
- 9.3 The participant is expected to stay informed about the event via newsletters, website, social media, etc..
- 9.4 By registering, the participant grants permission to Scouting Nederland and the event organizers to use any photos or videos taken during the event for publicity purposes. If the participant objects to specific use, they can notify info@eurosea.scouting.nl with their name and participant number.
- 9.5 Scouting Nederland and the event organizers may decide not to allow participants to take photos or videos at certain events.

10. Activities at Nawaka

- 10.1 When Eurosea 17 activities take place at Nawaka, the relevant rules of Nawaka apply for participating in Nawaka activities. Participants must adhere to these rules (Camp Rules: <https://nawaka.scouting.nl/wp-content/uploads/2025/11/Nawaka-2026-Camp-rules-V1.pdf> and Participant Terms and Conditions Nawaka :

11. Other Terms

- 11.1** Participants are expected to behave appropriately and comply with the rules as mentioned in section 2.3. The organization reserves the right to exclude participants who do not behave properly. The participation fee will not be refunded in such cases.
- 11.2** If exclusion occurs on-site, any additional costs (e.g. alternative return travel or accommodation) are the responsibility of the participant.
- 11.3** Complaints about the procedure or event can be directed to the event project management at info@eurosea.scouting.nl. Initially, the event organizers will handle the complaint. If necessary, the participant can appeal through Scouting Nederland's legal department (juridischezaken@scouting.nl).
- 11.4** Participation is at your own risk.
- 11.5** In all cases not covered by these terms, the organizing team will make the final decision.
- 11.6** Publication errors are reserved.
- 11.7** Every participant must be able to show a legal identification document at any time.
- 11.8** Dutch law applies to this agreement.
